For many generations, people have been relocating from one region of the world to another in search of improved livelihoods, security, and better living standards. In recent years, global reports estimate that over **280 million people** live outside their countries of birth. Uganda is among the nations that have experienced this steady inflow of people seeking new places to settle.

Despite its benefits, this continuous movement of people has sparked concern among local communities. Many residents are increasingly questioning the reasons behind this trend and its possible long-term impact. In some areas, including your own community, the arrival of new settlers has led to tensions and occasional conflicts. These disagreements often arise due to competition over limited resources such as land, jobs, and social services, as well as differences in culture, language, and traditions.

In response to these concerns, local leaders in your village have identified you as a key person to collaborate with them in examining the factors driving this ongoing population movement. You are also expected to recommend practical and lasting solutions that can ease tensions and encourage harmonious living between host communities and the new arrivals.

Task:

Write an essay that you will present to your community in which you:

- Explain the conditions that have led to these ongoing movements.
- using examples convince residents to accommodate the new settlers.

What is a Collage?

A collage is an artwork made by **cutting and pasting materials** such as paper, magazines, and fabric onto a surface.

Your Artwork Should:

1. Be done on **A3 board or A3 manila paper**
2. Show a **plate of food** (e.g., a meal, fruits, snacks)
3. Be made mainly using **cut and pasted materials**

Include the Following:

- At least **3–5 different food items** (e.g., fruits, rice, chapati, vegetables)
- A clear **plate shape**
- A background (e.g., table or surface)
- Neat and attractive arrangement

Materials to Use

Learners may use:

- Old magazines / newspapers
- Colored paper
- Fabric pieces
- Leaves or safe local materials
- Glue
- Scissors

Additional Requirement

Write a short explanation (3–5 sentences) describing:

- The food items you created
- Materials you used
- Why your work is attractive

Assessment Criteria (40 Marks)

- Creativity and originality – 10 marks
- Use of materials (collage technique) – 10 marks
- Arrangement and composition – 10 marks
- Neatness and presentation – 10 marks
